

Columbus Montessori Teacher Education Program Tuition Fees for Early Childhood 2017-2018

Early Childhood (2 ½ through 6 years)

The **Early Childhood** program consists of approximately 312 in-class hours spent in the Montessori adult learning environments provided at Columbus Montessori Education Center. In addition to lecture, demonstration, and practice, time will be devoted to collaborative learning. Expectations and requirements will be shared with students prior to entering the program and during orientation day at the opening of the course.

Included in the course fee are all resource materials and additional reading handouts. Additional supplies and reference books will be the responsibility of the student. Opportunities to purchase books and supplies at reduced rates will be provided at the beginning of the course. Many books are available for borrowing in the Teacher Education Program Office.

A formal contract will be issued upon acceptance into the program. The finance office at Columbus Montessori Education Center will handle all tuition and payment information. Full payment is due prior to the start of the program in July unless student selects a payment plan option for an additional fee of \$200.
